

Ehrlichman 'Says Fair Trial  
Was Denied in Watergate

BELLEVUE, Wash., March 7 (UPI)—In a handwritten letter to the editor published in The Bellevue American Sunday, John D. Ehrlichman asserted that Watergate defendants in Washington, D.C., had been deprived of a fair trial.

Mr. Ehrlichman came to Washington State last week for a visit to his wife and departed. He has been living in Santa Fe, N.M.

His letter was a comment on an editorial entitled "Elitist Justice," in which the biweekly criticized sentences of Watergate figures as being too light.
