Hervė (?) Lamarr (phonetic spelling), director of movie titled "Farewell America," interviewed by Colin edwards, broadcast by KPFA. Tape No. <3.

Book by James Hepburn was originally written in English and submitted to American publishers; none interested. First brought out in German by Axel Springer; also published in French and English. English edition published in September and available by mail in Montreal (Tara Editions Ltd, 63 Brésolles Street). Publication planned for Spain, Portugal, Italy, The Netherlands, Sweden, Czechoslovakia.

Movie is based on part of the book and shows Zapruder film, including four frames missing from official version.

Lamarr will not say how Zapruder film was obtained. Movie has been shown in Paris, London and Madrid. Lamarr showed it to prospective buyers and distributors, including television stations, in New York, Los Angeles and San Francisco; none interested, "too painful." Film available free of charge to those willing to arrange for audience space and projector; arrangements for this to be made with Tara in Montreal.
