HOUSTON, DEC. 30 (AP)-THE HOUSTON CHRONICLE SAID IN A COPYRIGHT STORY TODAY THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD WROTE HIS WIFE A SET OF INSTRUCTIONS IN RUSSIAN THE DAY BEFORE A SNIPER TOOK A SHOT AT FORMER MAJ. GEN. EDWIN WALKER LAST APRIL 10 IN DALLAS.

THE NEWSPAPER SAID THE SET OF INSTRUCTIONS HAS BEEN GIVEN TO THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

THE CHRONICLE SAID AUTHORITIES BELIEVE THE SNIPER WAS OSWALD, THE ACCUSED ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. OSWALD WAS LATER SLAIN BY JACK RUBY, DALLAS NIGHT CLUB OPERATOR.

WALKER WAS A FORMER COMMANDER OF THE 24TH DIVISION IN GERMANY AND A CANDIDATE FOR GOVERNOR OF TEXAS LAST YEAR.

THE CHRONICLE SAID THE INSTRUCTIONS LEFT BY OSWALD FOR HIS RUSSIAN-BORN WIFE TOLD HER THAT SOMETHING WAS COMING UP WHICH MIGHT CAUSE HIM TO BE AWAY FOR SOME TIME OR MIGHT CAUSE HIM TO BE ARRESTED.

THE NEWSPAPER STORY SAID HE TOLD HER WHERE THE JAIL WAS AND THAT HE GAVE HER THE NUMBER OF HIS POSTOFFICE BOX AND THE KEY. IT SAID HE TOLD HER OF A CHECK HE WAS EXPECTING TO RECEIVE FROM AN EMPLOYER. HE ADVISED HER HOW TO GET IN TOUCH WITH THE CONSUL OF TE

HE ADVISED HER HOW TO GET IN TOUCH WITH THE CONSUL OF THE SOVIET UNION, THE NEWSPAPER STORY SAID.

THE CHRONICLE SAID THE SHOOTING AT WALKER TOOK PLACE WITHIN THE NEXT DAY AND THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION IS INVESTIGATING A REPORT THAT OSWALD TOLD HIS WIFE HE HAD SHOT AT WALKER.
