basement, city hall
elevator, 9:30 a.m.

Radio evangelist Ray Rushing told Lt. Jack Revill that he went to city hall, Nov. 24, 1963, at 9:30 a.m., because he wanted to speak to Oswald. Said he rode up to the third floor in the elevator with Ruby.

Ruby was in his apartment until a few minutes before 11 a.m.

Comm. asked Revill how to locate Rushing. He told them Rushing lived at Plano, Tex., and a member of the First Baptist Church. At the time he testified Revill could not remember Rushing's address, but since he had interviewed him presumably he could have supplied the address from police files. There is no indication in the Index that Rushing was questioned by Commission.

Reserve officer, name unknown, allegedly said he saw Ruby coming down ramp to basement, and that another reserve officer had admitted him.
