After George Wallace won the Florida primary, a spokesman for Senator Edward Kennedy said that if Wallace posed a substantial threat to the Democratic party by making a strong showing in primaries in the North, Senator Kennedy would enter the contest. And now that Wallace has done so well in Wisconsin, after a very brief campaign, we will probably hear more about a Kennedy candidacy.
