

Jackie in Seclusion For Day

NEW YORK (UPI) — Mrs. John F. Kennedy spent the third anniversary of her husband's assassination today in the seclusion of her Fifth Avenue apartment.

Her children, Caroline and John Jr., went to school as usual. Tomorrow the family will leave for Newport, R.I., to spend the Thanksgiving weekend with Mrs. Kennedy's mother, Mrs. Hugh Auchincloss, at her estate, Hammersmith Farm.

John Jr. will reach his sixth birthday Friday and Caroline will be nine on Sunday.

A spokesman for the former First Lady said her mail, which averages 75 letters a day, has increased to about 175 a day in the period just preceding the assassination anniversary.
