FAY SAID THE BOOK, PUBLISHED BY HARPER AND ROW, IS NOT AN ATTEMPT TO WRITE HISTORY. FAY SAID HE HOPED TO SHOW THE LATE PRESIDENT THROUGH "A PERSONAL VIEW OF KENNEDY AS A FRIEND."
