MRS. KENNEDY 2ND NL A125

ACAPULCO, MEXICO, MARCH 18 (AP)-MRS. JOHN F. KENNEDY AND HER CHILDREN REMAINED SECLUDED TODAY AT THE HOME OF A FRIEND IN ACAPULCO.

THE KENNEDYS DID NOT LEAVE THE HOME OF FERNANDO PARRA HERNANDEZ. IT WAS FIRST REPORTED THEY TOOK A FOUR-HOUR CRUISE OF ACAPULCO BAY ABOARD A PRIVATE YACHT, BUT NEWSMEN WHO FOLLOWED THE YACHT SAID NONE OF THE KENNEDY PARTY WAS ABOARD.

MRS. KENNEDY, CAROLINE AND JOHN JR. ARRIVED IN ACAPULCO BY PLANE LAST NIGHT FROM NEW YORK. THEY WERE ACCOMPANIED BY MRS. KENNEDY'S SISTER, PRINCESS LEE RADZIWILL, AND HER FAMILY.

MRS. KENNEDY REPORTEDLY PLANNED TO ATTEND SUNDAY MORNING MASS AT A SMALL CHURCH NEAR THE PARRA HOME.

THE KENNEDY CHILDREN SPENT SOME TIME AT THE SWIMMING POOL AT THE PARRA HOME, BUT PHOTOGRAPHERS WATCHING FROM BOATS OFFSHORE SAID MRS. KENNEDY DID NOT LEAVE THE HOUSE.

THE AREA, A PRIVATE SECTION CALLED PUERTO MARQUES, IS ALWAYS GUARDED BY FEDERAL TROOPS BECAUSE FORMER MEXICAN PRESIDENT MIGUEL ALEMAN HAS A HOME IN THE SECTION.

THE TROOPS, STATIONED AT THE LAND ENTRANCE TO THE SECTION AND IN TOWERS JUST OFF SHORE, REFUSED TO LET NEWSMEN OR CURIOUS VACATIONERS APPROACH THE DOCK AT THE PARRA HOME.
