FERNANDO PARRA HERNANDEZN HER HOST AT THE WEST COAST RESORT, SAID HE ASSURED MRS. KENNEDY THE PHOTOGRAPHERS WOULD NOT INVADE HER PRIVACY AGAIN.

ENRIQUE FLORES, ACAPULCO PORT CAPTAIN, CALLED A MEETING OF RENTAL BOAT OWNERS AND THREATENED THEM WITH 15-DAY SUSPENSION OF THEIR LICENSES IF THEY TAKE PHOTOGRAPHERS CLOSE TO THE PARRA HOME.

MRS. KENNEDY, HER CHILDREN CAROLINE AND JOHN, AND HER SISTER, PRINCESS RADZIWILL, ARE VACATIONING IN ACAPULCO.

IT WAS REPORTED THE BOATLOAD OF PHOTOGRAPHERS CLOSED IN ON THE PARRAS' BEACH FRONT HOME THIS MORNING WHILE MRS. KENNEDY WAS HAVING BREAKFAST BESIDE THE POOL.

PARRA SAID MRS. KENNEDY TOLD HIM SHE WOULD REMAIN IN SECLUSION AT HIS HOME FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE WEEK.

MRS. KENNEDY AND HER PARTY ATTENDED AN EVENING MASS AT THE SAN JOSE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH NEAR PARRA'S HOME AND THEN DROVE BACK TO THE HOUSE.
