

Caroline's Photo Show Is Canceled

Caroline Kennedy's photo exhibit, scheduled for mid-March, has been canceled.

Nancy Tuckerman, a spokesman for Caroline's mother, Jacqueline Onassis, said "Somehow the press was informed and it was blown out of all proportion. A lot of attention was drawn to the occasion. It wasn't what Caroline had planned or wanted. This particular exhibit has been canceled."

Caroline, 16, was to exhibit a selection of photos from thousands she's taken over the past three years — of friends and family, wild animals, Greeks working on the island of Skorpis and other scenes.

However, both Mrs. Onassis and Caroline balked when Caroline was besieged at school with calls from the press. She and Caroline were also surprised about reports of financial negotiations going over rights to the photos, said Miss Tuckerman.
