HYANNIS PORT, Mass. AP - A spokesman for the family of Joseph P. Kennedy said early today that the former ambassador and his wife would be told of the shooting of their son, Sen. Robert F. Kennedy, D-N.Y., when they awoke this morning.

Miss Anne Gargan, niece and companion to the elder Kennedy, said she would await word from Sen. Kennedy's staff on the exact word of his condition before notifying the elder Kennedy and his wife, Rose. Both were asleep at the Kennedy compound here, she said.

Miss Gargan said the elder Kennedy previously had expressed a view that "it's better to wait when there is nothing you can do."
She said she would wait until receiving word on the condition of Sen. Kennedy.

In the meantime, she said there would be no immediate reaction from the family to the shootings.
