LOS ANGELES AP - The man who shot Sen. Robert F. Kennedy was identified today as Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, 24, a Jordanian from Jerusalem who recently has been living in Pasadena, Calif.

Los Angeles Mayor Samuel Yorty and Police Chief Thomas Reddin told a news conference Sirhan lived with a brother, Munier "Joe" Sirhan, of Pasadena, a department store employe.

They said identification was made through Joe and another brother, Adel, who were traced through the .22 calibre pistol used in the shooting. It had passed through many hands.

Chief Reddin said identification was confirmed by fingerprints on an application Sirhan Sirhan had filed for a job as an exercise boy at Hollywood Park Race Track.

The application, on file in Sacramento, was made sometime ago while Sirhan was a student at John Muir High School in Pasadena. It showed Sirhan was born in Jerusalem March 18, 1944.

At that time Jerusalem was under a British mandate. With Israeli independence, it was divided between Israel and Jordan. Israel took it over entirely last June in the brief Israeli-Arab war.

The mayor said the prisoner had in his possession a schedule of Kennedy's June speaking engagements.

He said Sirhan Sirhan also had four \$100 bills when arrested, and a clipping of an article critical of Kennedy.

Told repeatedly of his constitutional rights, he answered questions by saying, "I prefer to remain incommunicado."

The police chief said Sirhan did not appear to be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol.

The chief said he was "very cool, very calm, very stable and quite lucid."
