FBI in Sabotage Search

The FBI and Contra Costa County authorities today took over investigation of the latest Bay Area power line sab-otage — the destruction of three big PG&E towers early yesterday.

The steel structures, toppled by explosives shortly be-fore 5 a.m., were in the East Bay Hills in Contra Costa County, a few feet east of the Alameda County line.
