'Dreadful Act of Violence'

COLORADO SPRINGS, (Colo.) — (AP) — Vice President Humphrey said today "our hopes and prayers" are with Sen. Kennedy and the other "victims of this dreadful act of violence."

The vice president, staying at the U.S. Air Force Academy prior to a convocation speech there today, had retired when he received word Sen. Kennedy has been shot in Los Angeles.

He issued a statement through his staff saying: "Our hopes and prayers are with Sen. Kennedy and those others who have been the victims of this dreadful act of violence."

"It is a shocking and terrible thing that has happened. Our hearts go out to Mrs. Kennedy and the children and the families of the other wounded."
