

Funeral Schedule

Following are the arrangements for the funeral of Senator Robert F. Kennedy:

Today

5:30 A.M.-10 P.M.—The body will lie in state at St. Patrick's Cathedral on Fifth Avenue at 50th Street. The cathedral will be open to the public.

Tomorrow

10 A.M.—Celebration of a solemn high requiem mass at the cathedral. Admission is by invitation from the Kennedy family.

11:30 A.M.—The coffin will be taken to Pennsylvania Station and placed aboard a train to Washington.

4:40 P.M.—The train is expected to arrive at Union Station. In Washington, the funeral procession will move past the New Senate Office Building, along Constitution Avenue and past the Capitol and the Justice Building. It will go partially around the Lincoln Memorial, cross Memorial Bridge and proceed along Memorial Avenue to Arlington National Cemetery.

5:30 P.M.—Interment at Arlington.
