Flanked by at least five Service agents as well as state troopers, Governor Nelson A. Rockefeller returned here yesterday and told newsmen the attack on Senator Robert F. Kennedy wounds After flying into Albany County Airport aboard his chartered jet plane from Washington, a somber Rockefeller read a statement in which he said:

"All Americans of good will are stunned and ap-

palled. What strikes any one of us strikes all of us. We are gravely wounded."

"I am filled with sorrow for the senator and his fami-

ly.

"And this sorrow extends to all our nation. For such an assault on one man is an assault on our whole national life."

The governor canceled his scheduled appearance today to the National Press Club in Washington and all other appointments.
