

Nixon Cancels Politicking --'Shocked'

Richard M. Nixon yesterday canceled political activities for an indefinite time, saying he was "shocked and appalled" by the attempted assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

"My deepest sympathies go to the senator's family, which already has known more than its share of tragedy," said Nixon, candidate for the Republican presidential nomination.

"Mrs. Nixon and I join with Americans everywhere in offering our very best wishes for a swift and complete recovery."

Secret Service protection for the Nixon family, ordered by the White House, was put into effect yesterday.
