## Reported as Visiting Son

The mother of Sirhan B. Sirhan, accused assassin of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, is believed to have visited her son in his maximum security cell — his first caller except attorneys and police.

Mary Sirhan was disclosed yesterday to have conferred over the weekend with Public Defender Wilbur Littlefield about arrangements to see the 24-year-old Sirhan. Littlefield is scheduled to defend Sirhan.

Pasadena police have provided special protection for the mother and four brothers since Kennedy was fatally wounded in the Ambassador Hotel on June 5.

The security guard over the Jordanian immigrant is so tight that the sheriff's office would not reveal whether he had any visitors or whether he had yet been examined by two court-appointed psychiatrists. It was assumed he had.
