ING RANGE THE DAY ZEFOR Sen. Robert F. Kennedy was fatally shot, using up at least eight boxes of ammunition and at times shooting as fast as he could, witnesses at his murder trial said today.

One said Sirhan commented that his gun was powerful enough "to uill a dog."

A pretty blonde said the 24-year-old Jordanian took time to show her how to shoot her Christmas revolver.

THIS WAS THE FOURTH DAY OF TESTIMONY AT Sirhan's trial on a charge he in the California presidential primary last June.

Michael Saccoman, one of several who said they saw Sirhan at the San Gabriel Valley Gun Club last June

, was asked if he discussed hunting with the defendant.

When he said he was going on a hunting trip with the gun. I told him it was against the law because you can't use pistols. I EXPLAINED THE REASON WAS LACK OF ACCURACY," Saccoman said.

Asked for Sirhan's reaction to that, Saccoman said the defendant said: "I don't know about that. It would kill a dog." Saccoman said he took this to mean it was powerful enough to kill an animal.

At one point Saccoman said: "I noticed the type of ammunition he was using. The name on the box was mini-magnum. I asked why

that type is used for hunting. He said he didn't know too much about guns and that was the ammunition they had sold him." he was

Another witness, David Montellano, said he talked to Sirhan that day after being attracted because he was "shooting very fast . . . as fast as he could pull the trigger." Around Sirhan, he said, we

the six empty boxes of regular ammunition and two of "mini-mag" bullets.

Shown the murder weapon, he identified it as the eight-shot .22 revolver SQRHAN WAS USING.

HEAD, SAID SHE WENT TO THE RANGE WITH HER HUSBAND, Ronald, and Sirhan helped her with her gun. "He said the mini-mags he was using were better than what I was using," she said.

Her husband testified that Sirhan still was at the range at 5 p.m. Others have said Sirhan was there by noon.
