In Los Angeles, Sharif Bishara Sirhan, an older brother of the convicted assassin of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, pleaded not guilty to a Federal charge that he wrote a letter threatening injury to Premier Golda Meir of Israel. The older Sirhan's request for a reading of the alleged letter was denied in United States District Court.

It allegedly was received by Secretary of State William P. Rogers. Mr. Sirhan was held in \$25,000 bail and his trial was set for April 17.
