Sirhan Brother Convicted Of Threatening Mrs. Meir

LOS ANGELES, June 13 (AP)
— Sharif Bishara Sirhan, 39year-old brother of the assassin
of Robert F. Kennedy, was convicted in a Federal court today
of writing a letter threatening
Israeli Prime Minister Golda
Meir.

The sentencing was set for
July 2. The maximum penalty
for the offense is five years
imprisonment and a \$5,000 fine.
Sirhan was accused of making
the threat in a letter to Secretary of tSate William P. Rogers
last Feb. 18. The letter said,
"The dead conscience, Russianborn Golda Meir, will be shot
and killed . . . March 1." The
prosecutors said the letter was
traced to Sirhan through fingerprints.
