Los Angeles county officials have conspired to prevent a new investigation of Senator Robert F. Kennedy's assassination in 1968, Los Angeles county supervisor Baxter Ward said yesterday.

Ward, a Democratic candidate for governor, said, if elected, he would appoint a state commission to reopen the assassination inquiry. Ward said there were "unanswered questions" about whether the fatal bullet came from Sirhan B. Sirhan's gun.

Ward, who as a Los Angeles county television newsman questioned the invvestigation of the Kennedy assassination almost daily for several months in 1970, said.
