DA Scoffs At Sirhan Conspiracy

The evidence that Sirhan Sirhan acted alone in killing Robert F. Kennedy is "absolutely overwhelming," District Attorney Joseph Busch said yesterday.

Speculation about a conspiracy, extra bullets and a second gun is unfounded, Busch told reporters in disputing allegations made Sunday in New York by Al-lard K. Lowenstein, a former New York Democratic congressman, that Sirhan did not kill Kennedy.

"This case is absolutely overwhelming," Busch said. "It's not just to a reasonable doubt. I couldn't think of a stronger case."

He noted that at the time of the trial, neither Sirhan nor his attorneys raised the allegations now being made.

Sirhan is serving a life sentence at San Quentin.
