KENNEDY

LONDON, JUNE 9 (AP)-A "WHO KILLED KENNEDY" COMMITTEE WAS ANNOUNCED TUESDAY TO PUBLICIZE AND SUPPORT THE ACTIVITIES OF AN AMERICAN LAWYER WHO IS TRYING TO PROVE THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS NOT THE PRESIDENT'S ASSASSIN.

MARK LANE, A NEW YORK LAWYER, SAID HE IS ORGANIZING THE COMMITTEE IN BRITAIN BECAUSE "THERE IS NO OTHER WAY OF GETTING THE FACTS IN FRONT OF THE AMERICAN PUBLIC. THE AMERICAN PRESS ARE RELUCTANT TO PRINT ANYTHING OTHER THAN THE OFFICIAL VIEW."

LANE, WHO HEADS A SIMILAR COMMITTEE IN THE UNITED STATES, ANNOUNCED THE MEMBERS OF THE BRITISH GROUP.

IT IS COMPOSED MAINLY OF SOME LEADING FIGURES IN BRITISH LETTERS, INCLUDING PHILOSOPHER BERTRAND RUSSELL, LONG ASSOCIATED WITH PACIFIST CAUSES AND THE BAN-THE-BOMB MOVEMENT.

OTHER MEMBERS ARE PLAYWRIGHT JOHN ARDEN; CAROL WEDSWOOD BENN, AMERICAN WIFE OF A LABOR MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT; MICHAEL FOOT, LABOR MP AND LEFTWING JOURNALIST; KINGSLEY MARTIN, FORMER EDITOR OF THE NEW STATESMAN; NOVELISTS COMPTON MACKENZIE AND J. B. PRIESTLY.
