Two articles by Lane, quoting extensively from letter to Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark written by several FBI agents stationed in Los Angeles, in which they urge removal of J. Edgar Hoover because of his "rapidly advancing senility and increasing megalomania," misuse of federal funds, etc. Letter criticizes Hoover's administration of the FBI and contains complaints against Cartha D. DeLoach, Wesley G. Grapp, Clyde A. Tolson, among others.

Lane does not say how many agents were involved in writing this letter, nor whether it was signed.
