Critics of Warren Report Meet to Ask New Study

(Critics meet in Boston "this weekend." Story is datelined 2 Feb, a Sunday. Names mentioned in story: Mark Lane, Mae Brussel, Sherman Skolnick. Conference is sponsored by the ~~Assination~~ Assassination Information Bureau, "a group of young people working out of a Cambridge apartment," which "attracted about 1,000 people to its program of films, workshops and panel discussions."

("Mr. Lane was visibly upset by such charges [from context, those made by Mae Brussel and Sherman Skolnick], and in the closing session today [2 Feb], when petitions urging new investigations were distributed, warned against reaching conclusions beyond what could be substantiated. 'We should not make statements that most Americans cannot accept,' he said. 'We cannot require an acceptance of the unbelievable. It will set us back 20 years. It is their credibility that must be at stake, not ours.'")
