

A Senator Pickets the White House

Democratic Senator Mike Gravel of Alaska and two members of the Canadian Parliament briefly picketed the White House yesterday to protest the planned nuclear test at Amchitka island in the Aleutians.

Gravel's group was almost lost in what was a busy day on the sidewalk in front of the White House. Also picketing were members of a Quaker group carrying on a 24-hour-a-day vigil for peace in Vietnam.

Other demonstrators included a woman claiming she knew who killed the Kennedys and Dr. Martin Luther King and a man who identified himself as Harry Britain, a familiar figure around the White House calling for the "liberation" of husbands.
