NEW YORK, APRIL 16 (AP)-IGNACIO NOVO, WHO CONFESSED THE ABORTIVE BAZOOKA BOMBING OF UNITED NATIONS HEADQUARTERS IN DECEMBER 1964 SAID SUNDAY HE AND OTHER CUBAN EXILES PLAN A SABOTAGE CAMPAIGN WHICH WOULD INCLUDE "BLOWING UP RUSSIAN SHIPS IN INTERNATIONAL WATERS."

NOVO WAS FREED WHEN THE NEW YORK SUPREME COURT RULED LAW AUTHORITIES HAD VIOLATED HIS RIGHTS IN OBTAINING HIS CONFESSION TO THE BAZOOKA BOMBING.

HE TOLD A MEETING OF 500 CUBAN EXILES HERE THAT THE NEW CAMPAIGN WOULD BE WAGED AGAINST CASTRO AND ANY GOVERNMENT SUPPORTING HIM.

IT WOULD INCLUDE, HE SAID, BOMBING EMBASSIES, PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND OTHER INSTALLATIONS OF CASTRO'S REGIME OR ANY GOVERNMENT SUPPORTING IT.

NOVO WAS QUOTED AT THE TIME AS SAYING THE REASON FOR THE U.N. BOMB ATTACK WAS TO DRAW ATTENTION AWAY FROM ERNESTO "CHE" GUEVARA, AT THAT TIME CUBAN MINISTER OF INDUSTRY, WHO WAS ADDRESSING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
