Walker Is Awarded \$3 Million In a Libel Suit Against the A.P.

SHREVEPORT, La., Oct. 29 lodged against it would be appealed.

An Walker was awarded a similion libel judgment today against The Associated Press and The New Orleans Times-Picayune Publishing Corporation.

An all-male Caddo Parish (county) civil court jury decided after 1 hour 55 minutes that Mr. Walker had been libeled in an A.P. account of his activities during the 1962 desegregation riots at the University of Mississippi.

Defense lawyers immediately moved to have the jury's verdict set aside and moved for a mistrial on grounds that the awards exceeded the amount of \$2,250,000 in damages sought in Mr. Walker's complaint.

Second Victory

District Judge William Woods reserved decision on the motions and discharged the jury. In his instructions to the jury, Judge Woods had said, "No one may recover more for any item of damage than the amount sued for."

The A.P. said any judgment
