
**F.B.I. Is Silent on Report
Of Plot to Kill High Court**

CLEVELAND, Dec. 26 (UPI) — The Federal Bureau of Investigation refused today to comment on a published report that a Federal grand jury was investigating an alleged plot by five men to assassinate the nine Supreme Court Justices by blowing up their courtroom.

The report was in yesterday's edition of The Cleveland Plain Dealer. The newspaper, quoting sources close to the grand jury, said the plot was to have been carried out Nov. 18 but was postponed for unknown reasons.

The newspaper said the five men planned to kill the Justices because they allegedly opposed the high court's liberal leanings.

The plot was said to involve a former Chicago police officer; a one-time Wisconsin Ku Klux Klan official; two Akron men and a fifth man. Names of all the suspects were withheld until the grand jury completed its investigation, The Plain Dealer said.
