Rep. Charles S. Joelson (Dem., New Jersey) charged that national Communist party leaders had conducted a summer youth leadership school at Camp Midvale in 1965. Joelson said he had been given his information by J. Edgar Hoover. A spokesman for the FBI said the bureau "stood" on Joelson's statement and that there would be no elaboration.

Camp Midvale at Ringwood, N.J., in northern Passaic County.

Joelson quoted Hoover as saying students at Midvale were given instruction by top Communist party officials.
