Nixon Aide Reports Plan to Bar Cheap Handguns

WASHINGTON, Oct. 5 (UPI)

—A Justice Department official told Congress today that the Administration hoped to propose legislation soon that would outlaw the sale of "Saturday night special" handguns, but that it was troubled by the technical problem of classifying such weapons.
