

Millionaire Hunt

Says 'I Helped

Beat Kuchel'

DALLAS (Tex.) — (AP) — Oil millionaire H. L. Hunt says he was "instrumental" in the defeat of Sen. Thomas H. Kuchel by Max Rafferty in the California primary.

Hunt, long a champion of politically conservative causes, also warned he will try "by influencing votes" to block the bid of Sen. J. William Fulbright, D-Ark., for renomination.

"I think he and Kuchel are the two worst men in the Senate. I was instrumental in Max Rafferty's defeat of Kuchel," he said.

Hunt, one of the world's richest men, said of Fulbright, "He's just too far to the left to suit me."
