Anti-Red Ping Pong Tour

Los Angeles

Nine table tennis players from Nationalist China are in Los Angeles as part of a six-week United States tour to express opposition to the relaxation of U.S.-Red China relations.

The tour is sponsored by the "U.S. Victory Committee," headed by Dr. Carl McIntire, nationally syndicated radio preacher.

McIntire, at an airport interview after the group's arrival Tuesday, said, "President Nixon is going to Red China to give the Communists recognition they want . . . as leaders of all the Far

"We feel it's a disaster. It's a violation of our principle of opposition to violence, tyrants, and slavery."

Later, the "Free Chinese" displayed their prowess at a table tennis demonstration in the gymnasium of suburban Glendale High School.
