MRS. NHU SEEKS WHITE HOUSE AID: DENIED A VISA BY THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT, MRS. NGO DINH NHU APPEALED TO PRESIDENT JOHNSON FROM PARIS WEDNESDAY FOR PERMISSION TO VISIT THE UNITED STATES.

THE WIDOWED FORMER FIRST LADY OF SOUTH VIET NAM SAID SHE OUGHT TO SUE THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT FOR ASSASSINATION OF CHARACTER IN REFUSING HER A VISA ON THE GROUNDS SHE ENDANGERED THE WELFARE OF THE UNITED STATES "WHILE GIVING AMERICAN COMMUNISTS THE RIGHT TO PASSPORTS AND WELCOMING FOREIGN COMMUNISTS TO YOUR COUNTRY."

SHE REMINDED JOHNSON THAT WHEN HE VISITED SAIGON AS VICE PRESIDENT HE HAD INVITED HER TO VISIT THE LBJ RANCH.

MRS. NHU WANTS HER VISA IN TIME TO SPEAK AT A "TRUTH RALLY" OF THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY CLUB OF FLUSHING, NEW YORK.
