THE CLUB HAD INVITED MRS. NHU, WIDOW OF THE BROTHER OF THE LATE SOUTH VIETNAMESE PRESIDENT NGO DINH DIEM, TO ADDRESS THE RALLY IN PERSON.

HER VISA APPLICATION FROM PARIS WAS DENIED LAST MONTH BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT ON GROUNDS THAT HER ACTIVITIES WOULD BE "PRE-JUDICIAL TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST."

IN HER P SPEECH, MRS. NHU SAID WA NEW CHAPTER OF TRUTH
NEEDS TO BE TOLD, W AND ACCUSED THE UNITED STATES OF DESTROYING
WAN INDEPENDENT AND CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENT (IN SOUTH VIET NAM),
TO REPLACE IT WITH A MILITARY DICTATORSHIP. W

THE RALLY IN WAS ATTENDED BY ABOUT 300.
