

Dorothy Kilgallen Death Tests

NEW YORK — (UPI)—
Medical authorities began a series of tests today to determine the cause of death of Dorothy Kilgallen.

Dr. James Luke said an initial autopsy ruled out the possibility a heart attack killed the 52 year old journalist.

Luke said microscopic and toxicological tests would be necessary to determine cause of death and it might take a week before the results are known.

Funeral arrangements still are pending. A Catholic priest gave Miss Kilgallen last rites shortly after her death became known.
