CHINA-JOHNSON

TOKYO, NOV.26 (AP)-COMMUNIST CHINA BROADCAST TUESDAY A CHARGE THAT PRESIDENT JOHNSON HAS CALLED FOR INCREASED "AGGRESSION" IN SOUTH VIET NAM.

PEKING RADIO'S DAILY SUMMARY OF PRESS COVERAGE IN THE COMMUNIST CAPITAL QUOTED THE LEADING NEWSPAPER PEOPLE'S DAILY AS SAYING:

"THE NEW U.S. PRESIDENT LYNDON JOHNSON HAS ISSUED HIS FIRST FOREIGN POLICY DIRECTIVE CALLING FOR INTENSIFIED EFFORTS FOR AGGRESSION IN SOUTH VIET NAM."

THE BROADCAST ALSO REPORTED WITHOUT COMMENT THE KILLING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WHO HAD BEEN CHARGED WITH THE ASSASSINATION OF THE LATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY.
