

Oswald's Guns Valued at \$10,000

Dallas

Lee Harvey Oswald's widow yesterday received legal rights to his property, including the rifle he used to assassinate President Kennedy.

The 6.5 m.m Italian military rifle and a 38-cal. pistol Oswald used to slay policeman J. D. Tippett were valued at \$10,000 because of their historical interest.

Probate Judge F. W. Bratlett Jr. appointed Marina Oswald to handle the estate.

Other items left by Oswald included a diary, a four-pow-

er telescopic sight, a two-piece sling and a cartridge clip.

Mrs. Oswald's attorney, William Blaylock, said his client was anxious to sell the

items to provide for her security.

Blaylock said Mrs. Oswald had received a \$10,000 bid for the pistol and rifle from a gun collector. *United Press*
