Dallas, May 12 (AP)- Dist. Atty. Henry Wade said yesterday that Jack Ruby's mental condition "appears to have improved." He said in an interview his conclusion was based on information other than psychiatric reports.

Wade also said he does not expect Dist. Judge Joe B. Brown to rule for at least 10 days on a defense request for a sanity hearing for Ruby, convicted slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald, President Kennedy's accused assassin.

The District Attorney said Dr. John Holbrook, a psychiatrist ~~studying~~ studying Ruby's mental condition, is out of town this week and will want to observe Ruby again after he returns.
