

Psychiatrist Visits Ruby And Urges Hospital Care

And Urges Hospital Care

DALLAS, June 19 (UPI)—
Dr. Louis Jolyon West, a professor of psychiatry at the University of Oklahoma, examined Jark L. Ruby in his jail cell today and recommended immediate hospitalization.

Clayton Fowler, the chief defense attorney, said that Ruby had become so incoherent that "we can't communicate with our client at all."

Dr. West was quoted as sayingthat the condemned killer of Lee H. Oswald was in a "paranoid state."

Chief Justice Earl Warren and other members of the commission investigating the assassination of President Kennedy visited Ruby at the jail June 7. Since then, Mr. Fowler said, Ruby has not been able to "communicate realistically" with his attorneys.
