

## Attorneys For Ruby Seek Book

Attorneys for condemned slayer Jack Ruby filed a motion Thursday that would force Judge Joe Brown to make available to them an advance copy or rough or final manuscript of the book he wrote about the Ruby trial.

The motion was filed by attorney Phil Burleson in Criminal District Court No. 3, addressed to Judge Holland of Montague who has replaced Judge Brown in the Ruby case.

It asked that the defense be provided the copy before the Sept. 9 hearing on whether Judge Brown was disqualified from presiding at the Ruby trial because of the book.

The motion stated an advance copy would prevent defense attorneys from seeking to postpone the Sept. 9 hearing in order to study the book.
