Jack Ruby Has Cancer Surgery

DALLAS — (UPI) — Doctors at Parkland Hospital confirmed yesterday that Jack Ruby, killer of presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, is suffering from cancer.

Drs. Jay Sanford and Watts Webb of the Southwestern Medical School in Dallas, said Ruby had been operated on early yesterday and cancer was found in his lymph node.

They said it had spread from some other part of his body.

They said they did not know how extensive the cancer was, nor whether it could be arrested. They said they did not know how good Ruby's chances of survival were.

Ruby was taken to Parkland Hospital Friday evening with what was described as pneumonia. He was given oxygen and fluid in his lungs was removed. He was described in serious condition.
