DETROIT MARCH 20-(AP)-COUNSEL FOR THE ESTATE OF JACK RUBY SAID TODAY AN AGREEMENT WAS REACHED IN DALLAS, TEX., FRIDAY THAT RUBY'S HANDWRITTEN WILL HAS BEEN ACCEPTED AS HIS LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT FOR PROBATE.

ATTORNEY ALAN ADELSON OF DETROIT, WHO SAID HE HAS BEEN A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE RUBY FAMILY SINCE RUBY'S SLAYING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ALLEGED ASSASIN OF THE LATE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, TOLD A NEWS CONFERENCE THE AGREEMENT WAS REACHED BY A GROUP OF ALL INTERESTED PARTIES.

THIS WAS THE WILL WHICH DALLAS LAWYER JULES F. MAYER SAID HE FOUND WHILE CLEANING HIS GARAGE. THE WILL HAD BEEN FORGOTTEN FOR 16 YEARS, MAYER SAID.

THE WILL MAKES RUBY'S TWO SISTERS AND A NEPHEW, RONALD MAGID, RECIPIENTS OF THE ESTATE.

ADELSON TOLD NEWSMEN THAT RUBY'S ENTIRE ESTATE TODAY CONSISTS ONLY OF THE GUN THAT KILLED OSWALD BEFORE LIVE TELEVISION CAMERAS IN THE BASEMENT OF THE DALLAS POLICE STATION, A DIAMOND RING, DIAMOND WATCH, A HAT, AND A SUIT OF CLOTHES.

THE GUN IS IN POSSESSION OF A DALLAS COURT.
