CHICAGO (AP) -- JACK RUBY'S TOMBSTONE RESTED IN THE "LOST AND FOUND PROPERTY" DIVISION OF A POLICE STATION SUNDAY AFTER VANDALS CARRIED IT AWAY AND DUMPED IT IN A STREET TWO MILES FROM THE CEMETERY.

TWO TEEN-AGE BROTHERS FOUND THE 150-POUND MARKER IN THE STREET SATURDAY NIGHT.

RUBY, CONVICTED FOR THE SLAYING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, THE ACCUSED ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, DIED OF CANCER IN A DALLAS HOSPITAL JAN. 3, 1967. HIS BODY WAS RETURNED TO CHICAGO FOR BURIAL.

POLICE SAID THE MARKER WOULD BE RETURNED TO THE WESTLAWN CEMETERY TODAY.
