

**Senator Asks Ban on Schools  
As Cover for C.I.A. Operations**

STILLWATER, Okla., April 16 (UPI)—Senator Fred R. Harris, Democrat of Oklahoma, called Saturday for a Presidential ban on the use of universities or their projects as covers for Central Intelligence Agency operations.

Mr. Harris said in a speech to the state convention of the American Association of University Professors that those in C.I.A. who were involved in a Michigan State University case should be severely reprimanded or dismissed.

He said he called a meeting with C.I.A. officials for Monday to discuss the case, which the university acknowledged earlier this week.
