A Porno**Film and****The CIA**

Newsweek magazine says in its current edition that the Central Intelligence Agency commissioned a spurious pornographic film about former Indonesian President Sukarno in the 1960s as part of its efforts to undermine him.

Newsweek says an actor who resembled Sukarno was filmed "in a variety of compromising positions with a bevy of young women" and the film was to have been smuggled into Indonesia.

It adds the film was to have been passed off as the work of the Soviet secret police "but cooler heads prevailed at the CIA and the film was never released."
