Dallas, Jan. 16 - Jesse E. Curry, retired police chief of Dallas, has suggested in a book*just published that the entire circumstances surrounding the assassination of President Kennedy may not have been told.

Mr. Curry said that other euewitnesses, who said they had seen two men standing at the window from which the shots were fired, had been interviewed by the Dallas police and then turned over to F.B.I. agents for questioning.

"No statement about the second man or mention of any accomplice appeared in the F.B.I. report," ${\tt Mr.}$ Curry wrote.
