

**Spy Case Figure Well**

WASHINGTON, July 29 (UPI) — Lieut. Col. William H. Whelan, retired, a former Pentagon officer under indictment on charges of conspiring to sell military secrets to Soviet agents, was released today from DeWitt Army Hospital at Fort Belvoir, Va. He was taken there Tuesday after complaining of chest pains. Hospital officials said his illness was diagnosed as "exhaustion and anxiety."
