The New No. 3 Man In the FBI

William C. Sullivan, the FBI's top lecturer on the threat of communism, was appointed by Director J. Edgar Hoover as the bureau's No. 3 man yesterday.

Sullivan, 58, a native of Bolton, Mass., joined the FBI in 1941 and has been assistant director of the domestic intelligence division.

He will succeed Cartha D. DeLoach, who is retiring July 20 on his 50th birthday.
